Assemblage Wood Dining Table & Bench

Composed of hundreds of thin hardwood slats, the “Assemblage” series designs are as labor-intensive as they appear. The process begins milling lengths of wood to 1/4” thickness before passing through a custom molding tool cutting precise bevels on both sides. The slats are glued together three at a time along their long beveled edges forming incredibly strong and lightweight triangular tubes. The tubes are then glued into rows creating surfaces which can be cut and glued together repeatedly to create the desired shape. Due to the horizontal orientation of the long tubes within the top surfaces, one can gaze through from one side to the other.
