Relief Stone Cabinet - Six Door

This six door cabinet is made entirely of Brazilian soap stone in three stacking units. Precision water-jet cutting is used to cut all of the exterior components from a large slab of stone and folded around forming the doors, sides and back. This effect is accentuated by the white marble veining that wraps continuously around the cabinet. The triangular relief pattern milled into the stone removes excess weight while the remaining ribs retain the material's strength. The doors feature hidden magnetic closures and open effortlessly using custom precision machined brass and steel hardware. When assembled the cabinet weighs 1200 lbs. and rests on a hard maple base with six heavy-duty leveling feet.
