Relief Stone Cabinet - Six Door

Having worked the prehistoric material since the stone age, humans have made countless things from stone yielded from our earth yet this entirely stone cabinet is certainly the first of its kind. The exterior shell is made from a massive slab of soap stone precisely cut by waterjet to wrap continuously around the form creating the doors, sides and back. This can best be appreciated by observing the white marble veining. The triangular relief pattern milled into the stone removes excess weight while the remaining ribs retain the material's strength. This six door cabinet is made up of three stacking units, rests on a hard maple base with heavy duty leveling feet and features hidden magnetic door catches.
